Responsibilities

- Assist with daily health services care
 - Provide preliminary assessments of campers/staff requesting care
 - Screen campers on arrival
 - Respond to requests for medical assistance
 - Create a safe and welcoming environment for campers seeking care
- Maintain accurate and detailed medical records
 - Contact parents for missing or incomplete information
 - Perform administrative tasks as needed
- Enforce camp safety rules and policies
- Actively contribute to staff team culture and unity
- Set an example in attitude and behavior
